Thank you for your business! Refer to the care instructions below for a thick, lush lawn.

Caring For Your Hydroseeded Lawn

Water

- Let the hydroseeded area dry for 24 hours before watering. This allows the mixture to completely bond to the soil.
- It is essential to keep the mixture wet after the 24-hour bonding period.
 - For rotor sprinklers, set to run 4-5 times per day for 7-10 minutes each watering.
 - For pop-up sprinklers, set to run 4-5 times per day for 3-4 minutes each watering.
- Do not allow water to "pool" in any area. The first 21 days are vitally important for maximum germination.

Fertilize

- There is fertilizer in our hydroseeding mixture. This helps give the seed the extra nutrients it needs to germinate.
- After 3-4 weeks the hydroseeded area needs to be fertilized with a granular, slow-release fertilizer. This can be purchased at most lawn & garden stores.

Mow

- After 3-4 weeks your new lawn can be mowed. Make sure the ground is dry enough for a mower to go over it without sinking into the soil.
- Mowing will stimulate more growth, so it is important to set the correct mower height to avoid "scalping" of the new grass blades.
- Do not use a riding lawn mower or mulching mower. Make sure you pick up the grass clippings while establishing the new lawn.

Weeds

- There are no weed seeds in our grass mix. You may have weeds grow in the newly hydroseeded area because weeds are dormant in the soil or blown in from surrounding areas. Therefore, when watered, weeds will germinate as well.
- Broadleaf weed killer can be applied *after the grass has been mowed 3-4 times*. Mowing may also help choke out any weeds.
